AWANA – Clubber of the Month / Year Policy

The Clubber of the Month / Year (CoM/CoY) program seeks to reward children and youth who consistently strive hard week after week to get to know, love and serve Jesus Christ. AWANA recognizes this feat is rarely accomplished by children and youth alone, requiring a substantial amount of parental support and encouragement at home.

CoM are selected at the end of each month and announced the following month on the first Wednesday during the weekly AWANA Opening Ceremony. Additionally, those awarded CoM are announced and formally receive their certificates the following Sunday during the 11 AM service at Calvary Road Baptist Church. CoY are selected at the end of the Club year, typically 1-2 weeks before the End-of-the-Year AWANA Awards Ceremony.

In selecting a CoM/CoY, AWANA directors, secretaries and leaders should work closely together to ensure a "whole clubber concept" is used in determining a recipient.

Weighted Criteria

The following is a prioritized list of criteria used for selecting CoM/CoY:

- † Handbook Sections/Verses Completed – 40%
- † Club Attendance – 25%
- † Overall Good Behavior, Effort and Discipline – 25%
- † Participation in Club Activities and Events – 10%

Our goal is to provide a balance between both quantitative and qualitative methods of evaluating a clubbers performance each month.

In the end, it must be emphasized to leaders and parents that while CoM /CoY Awards are a significant accomplishment, they should not be used to determine a clubber's overall spiritual development or love for Christ. Each child and youth is different and will learn and grow in different ways. Improvement and progress made in a child's spiritual life throughout the year is the real measure of success!
