We are often asked the question, *"What can I do as a parent to help?"* Listed below are some of the ways you can support Sunday School, Children's Church and the other ministries of SonCatchers.

- 1. Make Sunday School/Children's Church a part of your life on a regular basis. Parents are the models for their children.**
- 2. Bring your child to his/her class on-time.**
- 3. Help prepare your child to arrive with a good attitude, a willingness to learn and equipped with a Bible and other required class materials (as designated by the ministry leader).**
- 4. Provide all required family/medical information as often as necessary to help us keep accurate church records.**
- 5. Volunteer to teach or to serve as a substitute teacher in the Sunday School/Children's Church programs.**
- 6. Volunteer to help with the children on special Sundays.**
- 7. Volunteer to share your expertise or other talents.**
- 8. Volunteer to chaperone for activities.**
- 9. Remain on church property while your child is participating in ministry. If it is required that you leave the church premises, please provide a working cell number so that we can reach you in case of emergency.**
- 10. Identify any/all medication/food allergies that your child has before leaving him/her in our care.**

If you would like to volunteer to serve in the SonCatchers Children's Ministry, please be aware of our requirements:

1. Applicant must be an active church member of Calvary Road Baptist Church in good standing for at least three months.
2. Applicant must complete an **Application for Ministry** which includes a list of personal references.
3. Applicant must submit to a national Criminal Background Check at the expense of Calvary Road Baptist Church.
4. Commit to the areas of responsibilities assigned to each ministry position for a minimum of one year.
