

What Is Baptism?

The word **Baptism** comes directly from the Greek word **baptizo**, which literally means to immerse, to submerge, to dip. Baptizo is the only word used for Christian baptism in the Bible. Baptism by immersion pictures the death, burial and resurrection of Christ. It is a living picture of the gospel.

Moreover, brethren, I declare to you the gospel which I preached to you, which also you received and in which you stand, by which also you are saved, For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scrip-1 Corinthians 15:1-4 tures.



When believers are baptized in water, they are identifying with Christ and are making a public testimony of their faith. They are outwardly demonstrating an inward reality.

Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death? Romans 6:3

Therefore we are **buried** with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. Romans 6:4

For if we have been planted together in the likeness of his death, we shall be also in the likeness of his resurrection: Romans 6:5
