Lesson Focus

After rising from the dead, Jesus appeared to many of his disciples in various ways. He offered instruction, reassurance, proof, and encouragement. He also demonstrated forgiveness and grace in the restoration of Peter, who had denied Jesus on the night of his arrest. Jesus proved to his followers that he had defeated death.

What You Heard in the Word

- Igesus appeared to many of his followers after his resurrection, including Mary Magdalene, the women who went to the tomb, two men on the road to Emmaus, and his disciples.
- ▶ Jesus provided comfort, instruction, and encouragement to his followers when he appeared in his resurrected body. At the Sea of Galilee, he spoke to Peter, offering forgiveness, restoration, and a mission to care for his sheep.
