## Lesson Focus

On Paul's second journey, Paul and Silas proclaimed Jesus in Philippi to a woman named Lydia, whose heart was opened to receive the gospel. When Paul and Silas were thrown into prison, they praised God and were able to share the word of the Lord with the Philippian jailer.

## What You Heard in the Word

- ▶ As Paul preached the gospel in Philippi, God opened Lydia's heart to the truth. She believed, was saved, and was baptized.
- ▶ Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns while they were in prison. God sent an earthquake that freed them, but they stayed to share the gospel with the jailer. The jailer and his household believed in the Lord Jesus and were saved.
