On his third missionary journey, Paul stayed in Ephesus longer than two years. There he spoke boldly to both Jews and Greeks, teaching them the truth of the gospel of Jesus Christ. Many people believed, and the message reached all of Asia. Later, Paul met with the leaders of the church of Ephesus to warn them about false teachers who would come in among the flock.
