



Lesson Focus

Paul wrote letters to the church at Corinth to admonish their worldliness and encourage unity and selflessness. He taught them what it meant to be a church—many members but one body—and how to use their gifts to love and serve one another.

What You Heard in the Word

- Paul wrote to the Corinthians to correct the division caused by people saying they followed different apostles. Paul urged them to all follow Christ and to be united.
- Paul described the church as a body made up of individual members but working as one to serve God and each other using their God-given gifts.
