



Peter Warns Against False Teaching

Lesson Focus

Peter wrote to the believers in Asia to warn them of the false teachers who would rise up in the church. They could be identified by their greed and sinful desires and would secretly bring in destructive heresies, even denying Jesus. Peter exhorted the believers to take care not to be swept away by their false doctrine.

Key Passages

Grades 2–3: 2 Peter 1:5–7, 2:1; 2 John 1:9–11; Jude 1:12–13, 1:20–23

Grades 4–5: 2 Peter 1:5–10, 2:1–3, 3:17–18; 2 John 1:9–11, Jude (selected verses)

What You Heard in the Word

- Peter warned that false teachers would come into the church. Believers must be growing in godly qualities and the knowledge of the truth to recognize false teaching.
- Inde urged believers to try to save those who are led astray by false teaching while the Apostle John commanded believers to not show hospitality to false teachers who are deliberately trying to deceive people with lies about Jesus and his Word.
